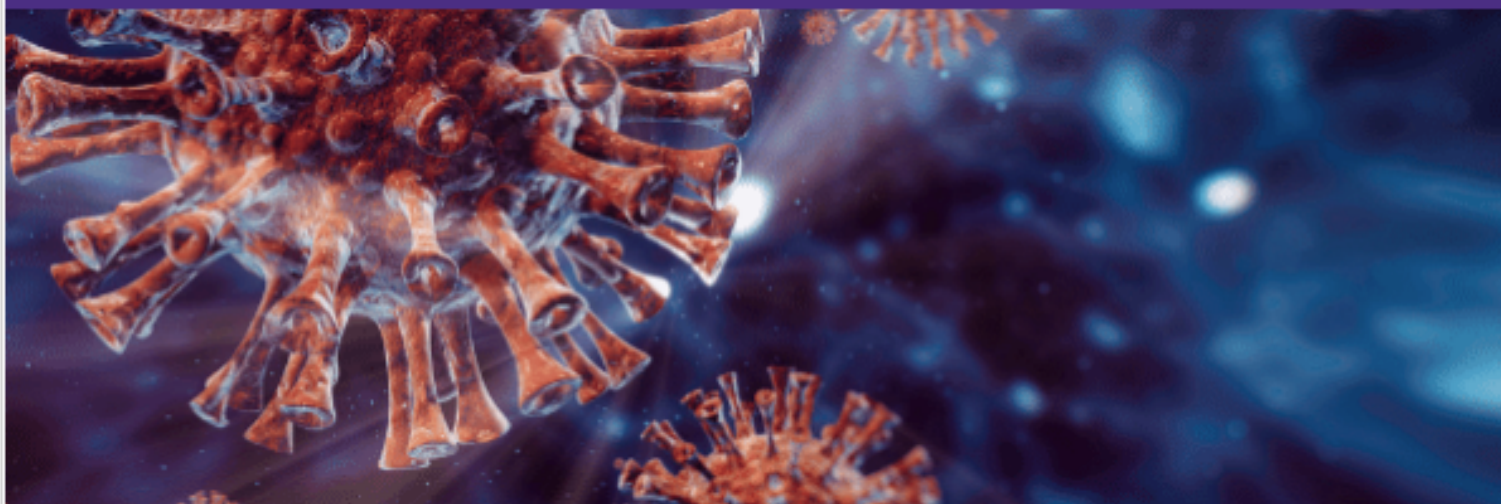
Almost \$20K raised for students
