



Independent Study Registration Form

Independent Study / BIOST 600 credit

Students who wish to receive academic credit for non-coursework study or research outside of thesis, practicum, dissertation, etc. can register for independent study credits through BIOST 600 (SLN - schedule line number varies by quarter). BIOST 600 is a variable credit course (1-10) and 30 hours of time over the quarter is a typical amount of time spent per credit. In Biostatistics, independent study is graded credit/no-credit.

Process for registering and receiving credit for Independent Study

- To register for credit
 - Student approaches a faculty member to serve as the Independent Study faculty advisor. Based on an understanding between the student and faculty member about the scope of the independent study, the student completes this form and then has it signed by the faculty member.
 - Student sends completed and signed form to bcurric@uw.edu.
 - Upon receipt of the form, the student will be given the appropriate faculty code to register for BIOST 600.
- To receive credit:
 - The faculty advisor submits the course grade, as for any other UW course. Credit for the course means that the student completed the independent study work as described in this form.
